What is FDW?

A fund supporting public-private-partnerships dealing with water related issues:

- WASH
- Efficient and sustainable water use, (particularly within agriculture)
- Safe deltas and improved river management.



Why partnerships?

- Complexity of related problems in water and food sectors.
 - System change & scaling
- Leverage; attract additional funding.
 - *Via business models*
 - *Via co-funding*
- Mobilise/transfer added value of private sector (e.g. innovation, technology, marketing).

What makes a good FDW-project?

- Contribution to development goals
(water, sustainability, gender, pro-poor)
- Public Private Partnership
- Business case/ revenue model.





How to apply for FDW?

- Concept note 31st December 2016
 deadlines: 8 December 2017
- Minimal 3 partners (NGO, company, governmental),
 maximum 6 partners
- Grant size: max €3 million,
 max 60% of project budget
- Eligible costs: Capital goods (hardware)
 Technical Assistance (project
 management, trainings)
