## **Join us in building the future of public transport in Stockholm, Sweden!**

*Stockholm County Council releases information on its Suppliers Day.*

**The Stockholm Metro system is to be extended to include eleven new stations and around 20 km of new tracks.**

**For Europe's fastest growing metropolitan area, this has now become a necessity. And is one of the many investments in public transport being made by the SCC, which is responsible for this new work.**

On October 26, Stockholm County Council will present some of the infrastructure projects for interested construction companies during a Suppliers Day in Stockholm.

### **Extensive expansion and a deep station**

The Stockholm Metro system last underwent extension work in the 1980s. Now the time has arrived once more and this will be a comprehensive expansion work that is to be undertaken. It will mean 20 kilometres of underground track and 11 new stations. There will be a number of challenges to meet, among these, at 100 metres below ground one of the stations will be among the world's deepest.

Stockholm County Council, responsible for the operation of its public transport system, has also taken responsibility for the entire expansion work. The whole is founded on a government agreement made with a number of municipalities, from 2014: The SCC is expanding its Metro system, while the Stockholm municipal councils are building 82,000 homes. With that, the entire funding of the underground system is now complete.

### **Information-rich Suppliers Day**

According to the plans, construction work will begin in 2018, at which time, the building of tunnels, entrances and depot capacities will be in full swing. Contract negotiations have now been

commenced. On October 26, the Stockholm County Council is arranging an information-rich construction companies' suppliers day.

"We will then be taking the opportunity of informing the industry about the procurements we currently have underway. Then, in the new year, we expect to start sending out preliminary tender invitation documentation. Construction start-ups of the major works are planned for about one year", says Mårten Frumerie, Head of Extended Metro Administration.

### **Suppliers Day, October 26<sup>th</sup>**

During the suppliers day, a presentation will be given of the entire Metro system expansion plan. The contract works will focus primarily on the construction of work tunnels and the main tunnels, as well as construction and installation work to be carried out in respect of the stations. In addition to this, the presentation will include "the expansion of the tramway to Kista and the expansion of the local railway, the "Roslagsbanan Suburban Railway", with a new depot and double track." The presentations will be interspersed with networking and opportunities of asking questions directly related to the projects and their specialists.

### **Great interest in the Metro of the future**

- "We are well aware of a substantial interest in our future procurements. It has been quite some time since the last extensions to our underground system were made and now we are going to see a major expansion to it, which, when completed, will simplify everyday life and provide increased travel opportunities for people. So now we are looking forward to meeting construction and facilities companies that want to be a part of expanding Stockholm's Metro system", says Mårten Frumerie, Head of Extended Metro Administration.

### **Take part in a tender**

Stockholm County Council uses the Achilles System AS qualification system TransQ to qualify suppliers. Tender documents will then be issued to those who have qualified. For participation in a contract you need to log in procurement tool TendSign. It is free to register up to ten users per number.
